

This year was very successful for us and we did not really have the time to announce all the new items and reruns properly. We would like to do this with this newsletter.

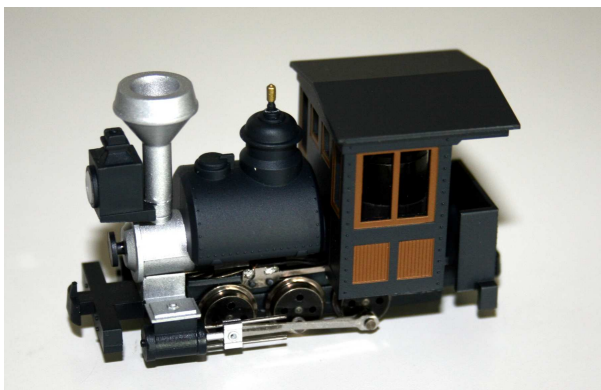
As already announced at the Nurnberg Toy Fair in the meantime the Forney locomotives and the Saddletank Porter have been released and are still available:

The two Forneys are realised as 0-4-4 locomotives with a swinging rear truck, while the Porter is a 0-6-0 (our first three axle locomotive). All of these run perfectly even on a radius as low as 140 mm.

The rerun of the Fiddletown & Copperopolis line is available and also the american style freight cars and caboose are available – although in limited quantities.

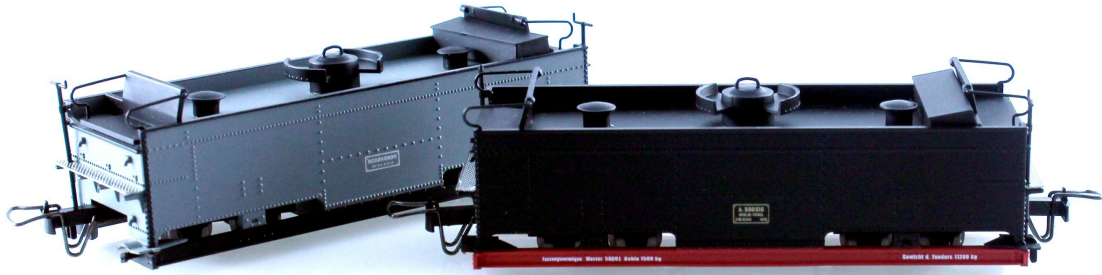

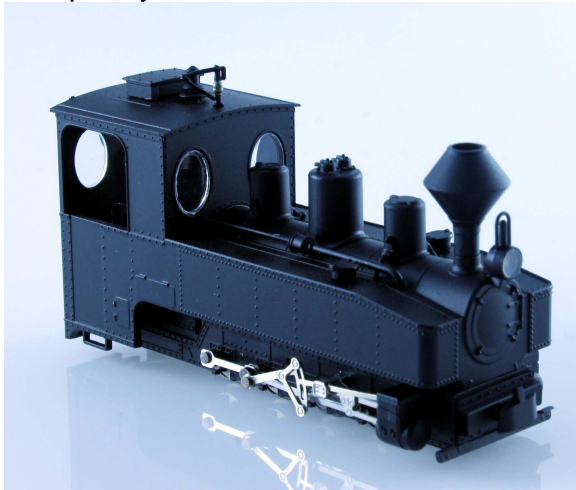


HFB Water-Tender 5202

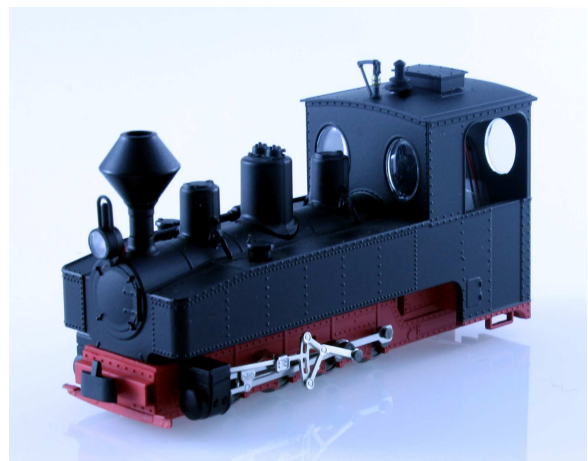

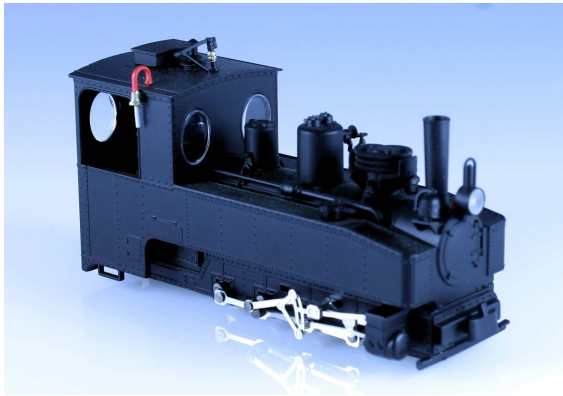
Brigadeloco 1027



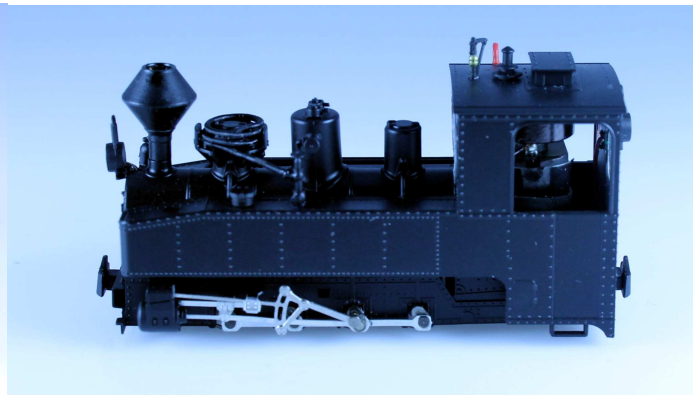

The variants 1026 (red chassis) and 1027 (black chassis) have no hose support, no bell on the side of the cab and a diamond smokestack, getting close to the prototype running at the Muskau Forestry Railway.

Just a few of the variants 1024 (straight stack) and 1025 (diamond stack) are available. Both locos have a black chassis.
