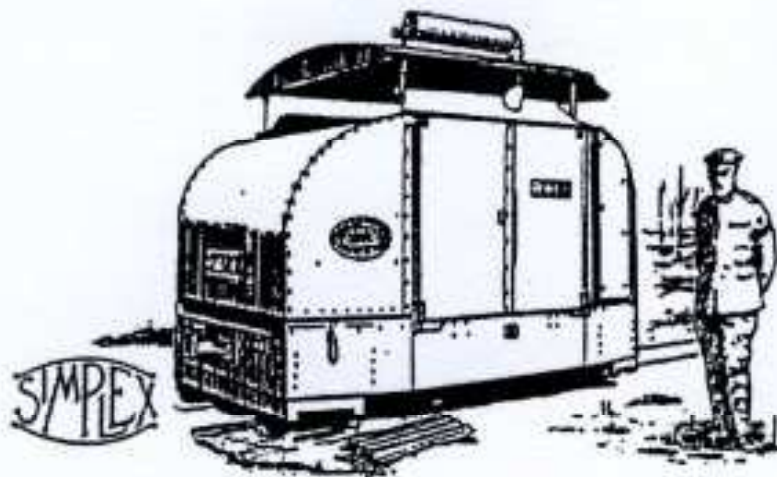


MM5 MOTOR RAIL & TRAMCAR Co 'SIMPLEX' PETROL
TRACTOR WAR DEPT LIGHT RAILWAY
'PROTECTED VERSION'



Used by the L.R.O.D during WW 1 on the forward area supply railways the loco body was built from armour plate. Similar in design to the fully armoured version (see our kit MM 1). The loco had a steel roof and deflector screens to offer protection from small arms fire and shrapnel. The most numerous of the WD 40hp 'Simplex' series, over 200 were built. Sold off as war surplus, some of these locos went into industry. At least 3 protected types are currently preserved.

The kit is designed to fit the Jouef H0e 'Decauville' 0-4-0 chassis. Alternative instructions are included for adapting the kit to fit onto the Arnold 'N' KOF III chassis.

Simple white metal construction lower body with etched brass upper works, roof, deflectors, visors, WD number plates and detailed parts. Freelance nameplates are included for 'demobbed' locos. Supplied with chassis mounting nut and bolt, 009 couplings. Parts are also included to build a non-powered chassis (**wheels not supplied**).
