

MM 11 DECAUVILLE 6.5 TONNE 0-4-0 SIDE TANK



A medium sized locomotive suited for use in quarry and field alike. The prototypes were built in large numbers by Decauville at Corbeil, France, who also produced the first transportable railway systems for agricultural usage. Many were exported to the French colonies and other countries. A number of similar 0-4-0's have been preserved in France by enthusiast railways and an example of one found in Britain may be seen at the Amberly Chalk Pits Museum, West Sussex.

The kit is designed to fit the chassis used in the Jouef H0e 'Decauville' 0-4-0 locomotive. Other recommends chassis units are the Bachmann 0-4-0 'N' scale locomotives. Detailed instructions are included for adapting the body to fit these alternatives.
