

UNITED STATES ARMY WORLD WAR 1 'PERSHING' ROLLING STOCK.

A series of kits modelled on the U.S.Army 'Pershing' wagons used by the Engineer regiments of the American Expeditionary Force. The wagons were designed and built in America and shipped to France in 1917. Nearly 3,000 pieces were in use, Flat-cars, Gondolas, Box-cars and Tank cars. The most numerous type being the Gondola of which over 1,500 were built. The term 'Pershing' is after General Pershing the commander of the United States Forces in France, although this was not a term used by the U.S.Army railway companies at the time. Much of the surplus rolling stock was left behind at the end of the war to be used by industrial railways France, such as the sugar-beet lines at Pithiviers and Froissy-Dompierre.

The kit features fully detailed under frame structure and separate floor units in polystyrene, bogies and side stakes moulded in A.B.S. etched brass brake wheel, bogie mounting bolts and 5.1mm diameter metal tyred wheel sets.
