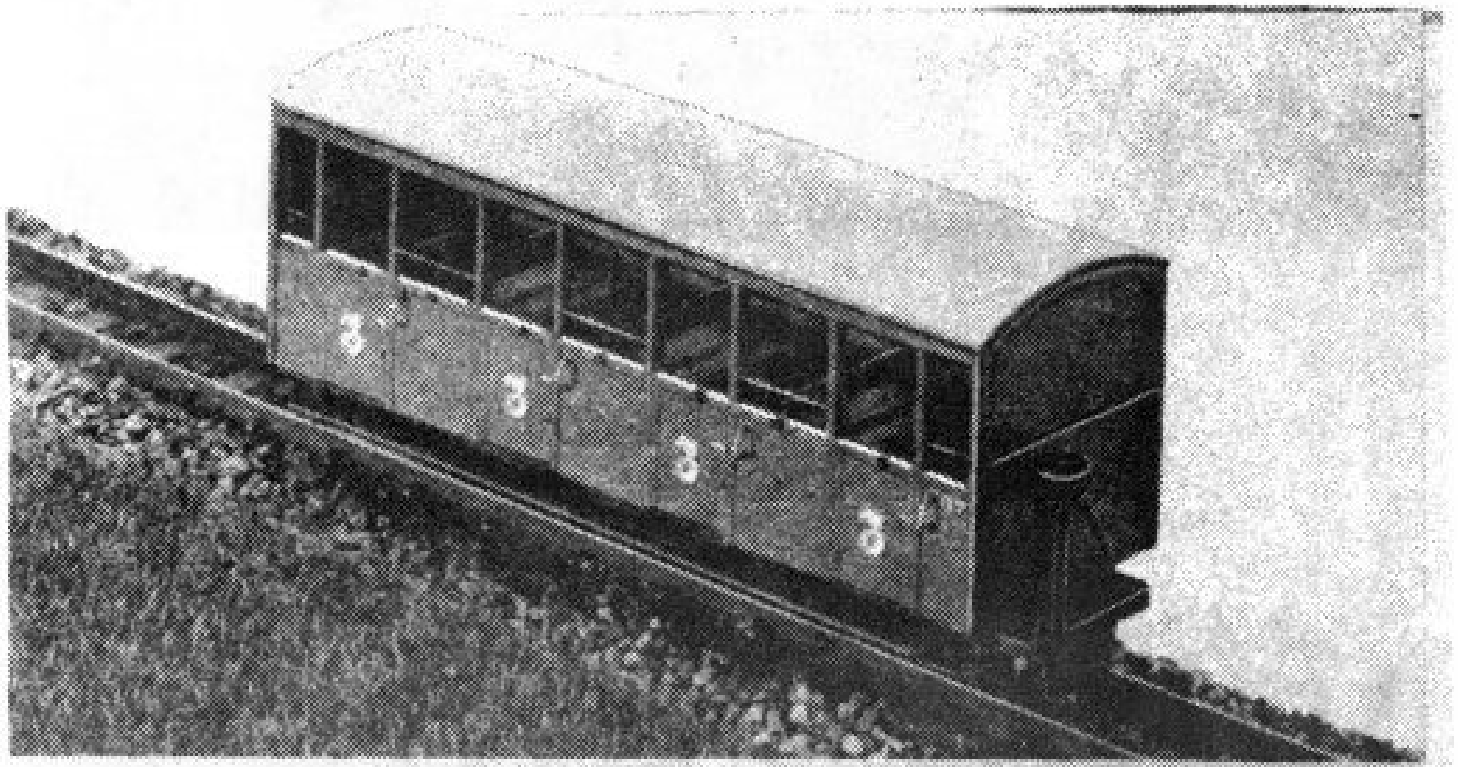


PARKSIDE DUNDAS

Festiniog Railway

In the early 1970's with the prospect of the 4 wheel coaches being withdrawn for rebuilding, two semi-open tourist bogie coaches were constructed. Each coach is of 4 compartments, all this class, with a seating capacity of 32.

These coaches were built at the Festiniog Railway's Boston Lodge works along the lines of the 'Toastrack' coaches supplied by Robert Hudson Ltd., of Leeds in 1923 using W.W.1 War Dept. Class 'D' underframes.

The kit contains plastic body including internal detail, one-piece plastic bogies with BICO metal wheels, handrail wire, white metal vacuum pipes etc. The bogies are designed to use BICO 009 Couplings (not included).
