


Vale of Rheidol Light Railway

Three identical 4-Wheel Brake Vans were built by the Midland Railway Carriage & Wagon Company, Shrewsbury for the opening of the railway in 1902. These vans were used on all trains as none of the original coaches had luggage or guards compartments.
